Be on your guard, stand firm in the faith; be men of courage; be strong. Do everything in love.

I Corinthians 16:13-14

Paul tells believers in this passage that we are called to some pretty high standards. First of all, we are to be firm in what we believe and always on our guard. If we get too comfortable or complacent, especially in a certain area of our Christian walk, it could become an area of weakness for us. Although we don't need to fixate on it, we do need to be aware that our lives are a

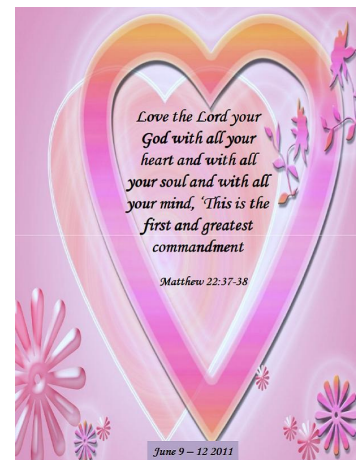

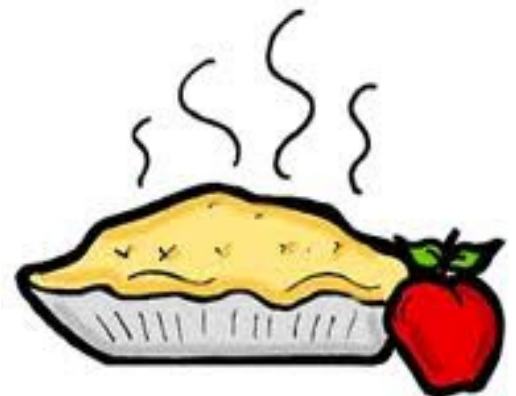
