Habana Tres Dias #9 is only four months away, and preparations are underway for both U.S. and Cuban teams. The weekends will be in February and March of 2013 with seven men and five women from the U.S. who will be supporting and serving on these weekends. We strive to have a team of 10 men and 10 women on the U.S. team as this helps us to reduce our overall costs. Therefore, we are looking for more team members.

This year we face something new when we arrive in Cuba. Because of a steep hike in customs duties* in Cuba, the U.S. team

will have some increases in expenses this year. The new import taxes were announced in about two months ago. The new customs tax allows travelers to bring in 66 pounds of miscellaneous goods without being charged. Everything after that gets taxed at \$4.55 a pound. The U.S. team brings in many of the decorations, supplies, palanca, and other miscellaneous items, with an average of approximately 85 - 140 pounds per person leaving between 19 to 74 pounds to be taxed. There are many other expenses involved in making this trip, but these new customs taxes will take a toll. If you feel lead to offer support, please send your donations to:

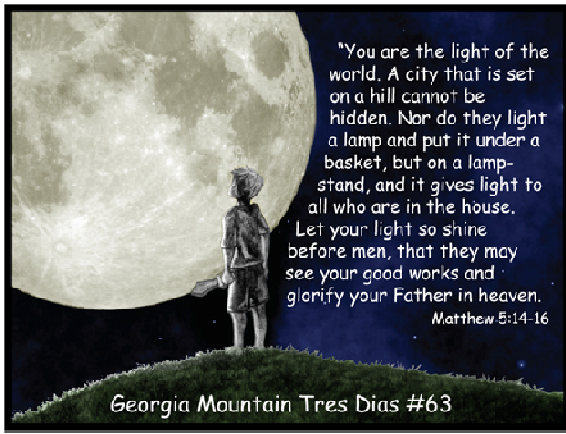

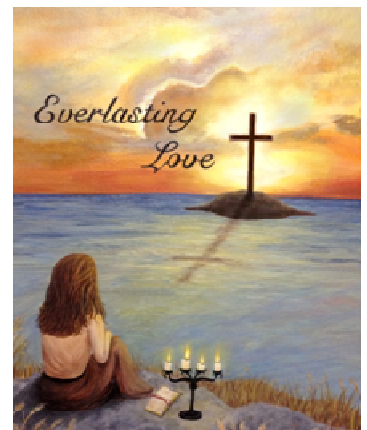
I would like to thank the community for their outpouring of love, Palanca, and prayers. You are the best community ever!
