Over the last few weeks as I began thinking about this meditation, one thing continued coming back to my mind. It was how we react to the daily worldly encounters that we have.

I See Evil...

Every day we are surrounded by visual images. They could be seeing drivers cutting off other drivers on Georgia 400 and the resulting anger, horn, or finger flip. It could be seeing an older woman leaving the grocery store in need of assistance carrying her groceries. Watching her struggle and no one willing to help. It could be watching television and seeing way too much inappropriate content and outright sexualized commercials, as well as risqué reality programming. We are subjected to way too much visual stimulation that is for evil purposes, whether it is for product advertisement or simply for the sale and promotion of pornography or pornographic websites.

What do we do? Proverbs 4:25 says, "Let your eyes look straight ahead, fix your gaze directly before you". If we are not focusing our gaze we will miss the path. As it says in Matthew 7:13-14, "Enter through the narrow gate, for wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow is the road that leads to life, and only a few

find it".

I Hear Evil...

Once again, we are constantly surrounded by attacks on our ears. We hear conversations daily that are condescending, sarcastic, superior, and profane. We hear parents that speak unkindly to each other and to their kids. We hear inappropriate jokes and bullying. We hear kids and adults making callous or ugly comments about others. We hear people making fun of others. Gossiping is prevalent in society and sadly also among Christians.

What do we do? In Mark 4:9 "then Jesus said, 'whoever has ears to hear, let them hear'". Because of the situations or circumstances, many times we have no choice in what we hear. How we react can encourage or discourage the evil that we hear. If you do not confront or hold accountable the Gossiper, you are passively approving of what you hear. You may even be encouraging them and their bad behavior.

I Will Not Speak Evil...

This part has been the area that has caused me the most disturbances over the last few weeks. In seeing and hearing we often do not have the choice or the ability to stop what we see or hear. The one area that we do have complete control over is our ability to speak and in controlling what we say.

Amos 5:13 says, "therefore the prudent keep quiet in such times, for the times are evil". It is impor-

tant not only what we say, but also how we say it. Ecclesiastes 9:17 says, "the quiet words of the wise are more to be heeded than the shouts of a ruler of fools".

Please be careful what you say, because we don't always know who is listening. Proverbs 15:4 says, "the soothing tongue is a tree of life, but a perverse tongue crushes the spirit". Also Proverbs 12:18 proclaims, "the words of the reckless pierce like swords, but the tongue of the wise brings healing".

I realize that I am not always going to say the right thing, but I also realize as Proverbs 18:21 states, "the tongue has the power of life and death..."

How About You?

The things I have witnessed with my eyes and heard with my ears recently have affected me. I am making a choice to speak a better word to all that I talk to. I am moving forward as Romans 12:2 says, "do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind..."

In conclusion, Jesus came to this earth and lived a sinless life among sinners. He saw the sin, He heard the sin. He was a friend of sinners to show them the way.

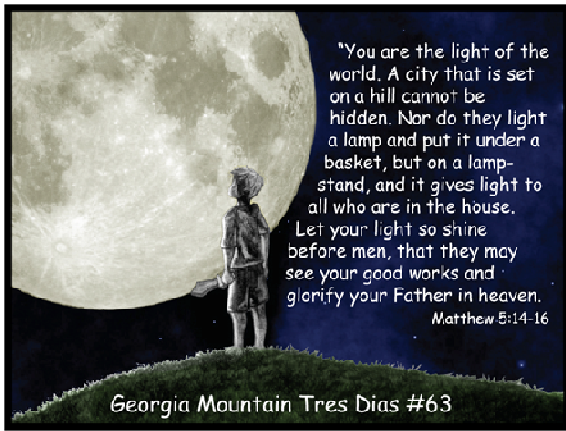

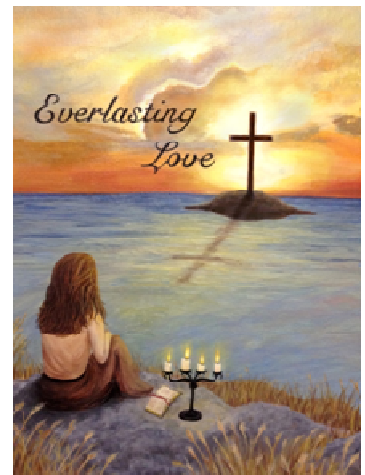
