## The Essentials

I think all of us would agree that God has used Tres Dias to touch countless lives. To the glory of God. The Lord Jesus has used Tres Dias to bless more churches, more marriages, and more individuals than any other organization in the north Ga area.

The main goal of Tres Dias is to move the individual, whether it be candidate or veteran, closer to living out the Gospel message of our Lord Jesus Christ.

So why does Tres Dias work so well at overcoming the lies of the evil one? In three days, hearts and minds are renewed. dark corners of the soul are exposed, the Holy Spirit refreshes and gives a new hope. This is not a small thing. People go to good churches, some people are leaders, even some pastors, but they didn't find it in church, didn't find it in months of counseling, didn't find it working harder, or sacrificing more. They found the life more abundantly in just three days, in ways that they can't explain to outsiders, it has to be experienced.

Tres Dias is a short course in Christian living. I believe this

short course was developed by the creative hand of God. I believe that GMTD was uniquely blessed because we, the community, have really sought direction from God in prayer for every decision.

**Prayer** is one of the **Essentials.** Without prayer, a person might say that the blessings came through good organization, or clever uplifting talks. Prayer points to a Holy loving God that cares about us, but also will not share his Glory.

So making sure that **God gets all the glory** is another **Essential**. It has been said that "God does not call the equipped but that he equips the called." The work that God has called us to should be beyond our grasp. We need to hold the view that without God, we can do no good thing. God purposely picked ordinary people, like fishermen or even a tax collector to turn the world upside down.

**Sacrifice** is another **Essential.** Those who serve are required to attend the meetings, stay all weekend, and pay good money to sleep in less than a comfortable setting. The sacrifice of love, will cause someone to lay face down in the hallway, or even sometimes in the cold wet grass. God will take self sacrifice done correctly and crush stony hearts. We don't move people, God moves people through our obedience and sacrifice.

Obedience is another essential. The written essentials, the practice and policy manual, the scripts, the time schedule, and even the vision for the weekend is given from God. I believe that God has qualified these elements of Tres Dias over and over again. I believe that to be disobedient to these parts of Tres Dias, is to be out of God's perfect will. If a person can't serve within these boundaries, then they shouldn't work on a Tres Dias weekend. This includes the rector, spiritual leader, or anyone. God honors the obedience of his people.

I believe that God calls ordinary people to serve in all the positions that make up Tres Dias, from the kitchen to the chairman of the board. Luke I 2:48 says, "For everyone to whom much is given, from him much will be required." That includes being diligent to act when called for, with the authority and responsibility given to each position.



Vida Nueva is a weekend retreat for young men and women ages 15-20. Vida Nueva is Spanish for "New Life" and like the Tres Dias, VN weekends are intended as an encounter with lesus Christ. The weekends are similar to the structure of a Tres Dias weekend with certain changes to make it more relevant for teens. VN weekends begin on Friday evening and end on Sunday evening. The cost to sponsor someone on a VN weekend is \$80. If you have a teenager who you would like to sponsor, you can download an application at the web-site www.gmvn.net. Georgia Mountains VN currently holds two sets of weekends a year, one in the fall and one in the spring.
