Secretariat Spotlight-Food Person

The Constitution and By-Laws of GMTD set the following qualifications to be the Food Person or Food Couple. Food is handled by a single or married person or a married couple. The person or couple is responsible for all matters pertaining to the physical assets and arrangements for the weekend regarding food and food preparation. The person or couple communicates with the Head/Assistant Head Kitchen Chas on the budget, requested menu, food and supplies provided by GMTD for the weekend. Responsible for the storage of Georgia Mountain Tres Dias kitchen and food supplies. The person or couple maintains an accurate inventory of supplies and food items, and purchase them as needed for each weekend. They also arrange for the transportation of the kitchen and food supplies to and from the weekend site and supervise the take down of all kitchen and food supplies as well as the cleaning of the kitchen facility at the close of the weekend. This person or couple prepares an accurate record of the kitchen expenses for the Treasurer on a per weekend basis and participates in overall guidance and planning of Tres Dias activities.

Table Palanca – 6 tables, minimum of

65 individual items.

Bed Palanca – 45 for candidates, 81 for team. Team members may receive individual bed palanca. Palanca for specific candidates will be placed in their Sunday bags.

Kitchen Palanca – 126 place settings.

Oven Palanca – Please drop off at the Palanca room, not the kitchen.

Palanca Letters – Write the candidate's name on the letter and in the left upper corner write who the letter is from: sponsor, husband, wife, friend, etc. Letters from family and friends need to be at the camp no later than Saturday night. The earlier the better.

Georgia Mountains Vida Nueva

Vida Nueva is a weekend retreat for young men and women ages 15-20. Vida Nueva is Spanish for "New Life" and like the Tres Dias, VN weekends are intended as an encounter with Jesus Christ. The weekends are similar to the structure of a Tres Dias weekend with certain changes to make it more relevant for teens. VN weekends begin on Friday evening and end on Sunday evening. The cost to sponsor someone on a VN weekend is \$80. If you have a teenager who you would like to sponsor, you can download an application at the web-site www.gmvn.net. A group of teens who have made a Vida Nueva

Georgia Mountains VN currently holds two sets of weekends a year, one in the spring and one in the fall. The next set of weekends are October 17-20, 2019 for the Young Women and October 24-27, 2019 for the Young Men.
