As I write this meditation, I thought of how many of my friends, family, church family, and Tres Dias friends were struggling with everyday life issues from the minor issues to major problems and struggles. I read a few years ago about the dreaded D's.

Georgia Mountains Vida Nueva

Vida Nueva is a weekend retreat for young men and women ages 15-20. Vida Nueva is Spanish for "New Life" and like the Tres Dias, VN weekends are intended as an encounter with Jesus Christ. The weekends are similar to the structure of a Tres Dias weekend with certain changes to make it more relevant for teens. VN weekends begin on Friday evening and end on Sunday evening.
