ROVER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. The responsibility of the Rover (upcoming Rector) is to become expertly familiar with all areas of the Tres Dias Weekend.
2. The Rover will receive a time schedule and script for the weekend. You are encouraged to follow along through the script and time schedule and make notes as the weekend progresses.
3. It is imperative to observe ALL the functions of the various service areas that have not already been experienced.
4. Attendance is required at all meetings (Core Leaders, Professor, & Area Head ect.) as well as all full team meetings.
5. A good deal of time should be spent in the Rollo Room observing candidates as prospective team members. Take opportunities to mingle with the candidates and team.
6. A notebook for recording observations will be very helpful.
7. The Rover is still under the authority of the rector and should not give instruction to team members.
8. During meal times the Rover should sit in different areas amongst the candidates and team.
9. During Chapel visits the Rover should insert their presence within the candidates when opportunity arises.
10. There should be an emphasis on more interaction with the Candidates.
